

Annual conference theme: the changing face of international education


The theme of our UK ENIC annual conference - online on 4 November - will be: The changing face of international education.

Guidance published on mutual recognition arrangements for professional qualifications

The Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) has published [guidance \[PDF\]](#) on the arrangements to facilitate recognition of professional qualifications.

The qualifications covered by the Mutual Recognition Agreement (MRA) are the UK Bachelor, Master and Doctoral degrees as well as the Peruvian *Grado de Bachiller / Título Profesional, Título de Segunda Especialidad Profesional* (excluding medical residency programmes (*programas de residentado médico*), which are governed by separate regulations), the *Grado de Maestro* and *Grado de Doctor*.
