### GETS Higher English language test benchmarked to the CEFR

UK NARIC have independently evaluated the GETS Higher English language test against the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) and found it comparable to:

- At least CEFR B2 standard where a minimum score of 75/100 is achieved
- CEFR B1 standard where a minimum score of 50/100 is achieved
- CEFR A2 where a minimum score of 25/100 is achieved. READ MORE
